**Garden Ambassadors** greatly enhance the visitor experience by informing, assisting, and engaging with visitors from the Garden Ambassador Shed, as well as roaming throughout the Gardens.

**Volunteer Guides** who lead visitors through the Gardens on free guided walks and conduct exclusive special interest walks on a variety of topics as well as roam the Gardens and occupy the shed.

- After 6 months as a Garden Ambassador, you'll receive training to become a Volunteer Guide.

# Who are we looking for?

### We are seeking people who:

- Have an interest in gardens, plants, and environmental education
- Enjoy engaging with people of all backgrounds
- Are comfortable working outdoors in all weather across the seasons
- Are team players with a positive and proactive attitude
- Have a passion for inspiring others about the value of plant life
- Are willing to learn and communicate visitor regulations that help protect the Gardens and ensure public safety
- Are open to progressing to the Volunteer Guide Role after six months as a Garden Ambassdor if the role suites.

#### What Does a Garden Ambassador Do?

You will be part of our **Visitor Experience** team — operating out of our **Garden Ambassador Shed** - a information shed used to welcome, educate, and engage with the public throughout the Gardens as well as roaming the Gardens.

#### A typical shift includes:

- Greeting visitors and offering directions or information
- Sharing fun facts about the Gardens and plants
- Promoting respectful and safe use of the space
- Raising awareness about conservation and sustainability
- Reporting any safety concerns or incidents

#### Shifts:

- Daily (including weekends)
- 4 hours 10:30am 2:30pm
- Each volunteer is expected to fill 2 shifts per month

## **Volunteer Requirements**

To take part in the Garden Ambassador Program volunteers must:

- Make a commitment of 12 months
- Be available for **two 4-hour shifts per month** including the weekends.
- Be available to attend the 3-day training program held on the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> of February 2026
  10:00am 3:00pm at Cranbourne Gardens.
- Have (or be willing to obtain) a current Working with Children Check
- Have computer and email access
- Attend Monthly volunteer meetings (held on Mondays)
- Use the **Better Impact** Volunteer software system, training provided
- Wear the official Royal Botanic Gardens volunteer uniform and name badge
- Participate in annual volunteer training, surveys and reviews
- Abide by the Victorian Code of Conduct and Royal Botanic Gardens Victoria Policies and Procedures

Selected applicants will be invited to attend an in-person interview in **late November to early December**.

# 4. Training Program

Successful applicants must attend all three days of the in-person training program:

3rd, 10th, and 17th February 2026

10:00 am - 3:00 pm

Cranbourne Gardens

Training includes a mix of practical activities, reading, and online learning to prepare you for your role.

#### 5. Submit Documentation

Provide your Working with Children Check (or proof that you have applied).

#### 6. Start Volunteering!

Upon completing training, you'll join the Garden Ambassador team and be paired with an experienced mentor for support.

A 3-month probationary period allows both you and the Gardens to ensure the role is a good fit.
