Meeting Point

Observatory House, via the **Schools Entrance**, **Birdwood Ave**, **South Yarra**, **opposite Shrine of Remembrance between Observatory Lawn and the Herbarium**. Bus parking is along Birdwood Ave. See Interactive Map

On Arrival

Please arrive 15 minutes prior to the scheduled program to ensure time for a snack and toilet stop. Late arrival will reduce the length of your program as the program will finish at the allocated time. Bag storage is available. Schools are welcome to spend time at the gardens either side of their booked program.

Cancellations by Organisation (i.e. school)

Cancellation of a program must be made by the booking contact at least 14 days prior to the booked program. If not, a cancellation fee of \$306 per class will be invoiced to the school. The fee does not apply in the circumstances of extreme weather or RBGV cancellations.

Cancellations by RBGV

On rare occasions RBGV may be required to cancel a program due to circumstances beyond our control (e.g. extreme weather conditions). In such circumstances we will prioritise rescheduling of the program to a mutually agreeable date.

Weather

Sessions may not operate in extreme or dangerous weather conditions e.g. temperatures over 35c, very high winds, lightning, hail or when the air quality is classed as hazardous. We reserve the right to postpone or alter sessions due to extreme weather.

What to wear

Please be prepared for the weather conditions anticipated for the day as sessions are held outside and exploration of the gardens is involved. Students must be dressed appropriately
